LICENSE PERIOD:

Duration of Event; no carnival shall operate at any site in the city of Milwaukee between the hours of midnight and 10 a.m., or for more than 7 consecutive days.

APPLICATION:

Submit application to City Clerk License Division, City Hall, 200 E. Wells St., Room 105, Milwaukee, WI.

Applicants seeking carnival site permits are required to submit applications to the City Clerk License Division **no later than 45 days before the event** for which the permit is sought is to be held. A carnival site permit may be issued to an applicant who files his or her application fewer than 45 days before the event for which the permit is sought provided the applicant waives his or her right to an appeal of any decision made by a Common Council member.

FEE:

The \$50 fee **must be submitted with application**. Make checks payable to: CITY OF MILWAUKEE.

ALTERNATIVE DATES:

Applicants may at the time of application specify on the application alternative dates for which the permit is sought in the event of inclement weather. Whenever a permit holder wishes to invoke the alternative dates specified on the application, the permit holder shall submit to the License Division the carnival site permit issued for the original dates and a sworn written statement that no event was operated on the dates specified on the permit. A new carnival site permit will be issued.

REQUIREMENTS:

Sections Comm Ch. 34.04 (1) and Comm Ch. 2.20 of the Wisconsin Administrative Code require that amusement rides be registered with the Department of Commerce each calendar year. Amusement rides shall not be operated in the city of Milwaukee unless and until the carnival operator has been issued a registration certificate. Please contact the Department of Commerce, Building and Safety Division at (608) 266-2780 to verify that a current registration certificate has been issued to your carnival operator.

You may need a temporary occupancy permit available from the City of Milwaukee, Development Center, Permit Desk, 809 N. Broadway, 1st floor, (414) 286-8211. The occupancy permit must be issued in the name of the same legal entity as the carnival site permit applicant.

The granting of the permit is subject to the approval of the Common Council member representing the district in which the site for which the permit is sought is located. In making his or her determination, the Common Council member shall consider factors established under s. 87-14-4-b, MCO.

If your organization plans to serve beer or wine, you must hold a Class "B" Special license and those dispensing the beer or wine must be licensed to do so as a bartender or a temporary bartender. Individuals without a bartender license may work only under the direct supervision of a licensed bartender.

REFUND OF LICENSE FEE: If an application is withdrawn or denied, you are eligible for a refund in the amount of \$25, provided the refund is requested no later than one year from the date of withdrawal or denial of the application. If a license is not issued, the refund must be requested no later than one year from the date of application, unless the license has been granted, in which case no later than one year from the date of granting of the license.

REGULATIONS RELATING TO CARNIVAL SITES ARE LOCATED IN SECTION 87-14 OF THE MILWAUKEE CODE OF ORDINANCES AND MAY BE VIEWED ONLINE AT WWW.MILWAUKEE.GOV/ORDINANCES or purchased from the Legislative Reference Bureau in City Hall, Room B-11.

The undersigned shall not willfully refuse to provide the services offered under this license, or add charges or require deposits not required of the general public because of race, color, sex, religion, national origin or ancestry, age, handicap, lawful source of income, marital status, sexual orientation, gender identity or expression, familial status or the fact that a person is now or has been a member of the military service, whether dressed in uniform or not; and not seek such information as a condition of employment, or penalize any employee or discriminate in the selection of personnel for training or promotion on the basis of such information.
